

STOP PRESS - No Uniform at Digitech

Thank you for your feedback regarding uniform. Over 80% of you thought we should not have a uniform, but 60% of you thought that there should still be some form of dress code. We have therefore taken the bold step to remove uniform from the 2 July 2018.

Rationale

This is a 14-19 school that has a mature college feel. Students are dressed for business, but in reality the business dress does not reflect the employers and sectors that we work with where the dress code is much more casual.

Whilst it is certainly easier to define what is correct and incorrect dress with a uniform we do believe that non uniform will suit the ethos and culture of the school.

This said, we do need to ensure that students are dressed appropriately for a public working environment. As a simple gauge, students should be dressed as if they are going on work experience or an interview for college.

There are some NO's

- NO coats/gilletes in the building – these must be removed when you enter the building, hung up or put in a bag
- NO hats or hoods to be worn in the building
- NO slogans or large logos
- NO ripped jeans
- NO low cut jeans/underwear on show
- NO strappy or low cut tops
- NO crop/belly tops
- NO thin leggings
- NO thighs showing - shorts and skirts need to be knee length
- NO flip flops or sandals
